Although we may be fooled into thinking spring has arrived, with the early arrival of Daffodils blooming in the Council gardens and the occasional mild sunny day, we are still in the later stages of winter and are still seeing the usual winter illnesses.

Some handy winter hints to keep yourself and your family safe:

Watch out on those frosty mornings, that you don't slip on icy paths and be especially careful driving in icy conditions. Allow extra time before you depart to clear ice off all your windows and mirrors, if your car is kept outside overnight. Be vigilant with heaters and fireplaces that you don't accidently burn yourself or catch fire to clothing. The New Zealand Fire Service recommends the "heater-metre" rule – always keep furniture, curtains, clothes and children at least **ONE METRE AWAY** from heaters and fireplaces.

Phlebotomy Service: (blood tests)

If you need a blood test, you no longer have to go to the Laboratory in town!

Fairy Springs run a Phlebotomy Clinic every Monday and Wednesday afternoon 1.30pm till 3.30pm and Friday morning 10am till 12pm.

Drop in Clinics:

Did you know that we offer a daily Drop in Clinic?

Central Health: Monday to Friday 9am till 11am and 2pm till 4pm

Fairy Springs: Monday to Friday 9am till 11am

If you are in severe pain or are acutely unwell, or have a sick child or baby, you can attend these clinics. You will be placed on a waiting list to be seen by a Doctor but depending on circumstances, you may be triaged by a Nurse as well. Due to time restraints we need these appointments to address ONE problem only, and only ONE patient per appointment.

Do you need help to quit smoking?

Help is available for any of our patients wishing to give up smoking. We can offer support by way of a Nurse appointment to discuss suitable nicotine replacement options. The cost of this appointment is equal to just over half the price of a packet of cigarettes. If it's your first step to quitting, it's well worth it!
